BONDAGE

“And if you faithfully obey the voice of the Lord your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the Lord your God.”

B. Want **instant** gratification.

C. **Waste** finances foolishly.

He who loves wisdom makes his father glad, but a companion of prostitutes squanders his wealth. Proverbs 29:3

Dumb Excuse for **Buying Things**

II. **Freedom** from **Bondage**

A. **Acknowledge** the bondage.

“But when he came to himself, he said, ‘How many of my father’s hired servants have more than enough bread . . .’”
Luke 15:17a

B. **Begin** a plan.

. . . but I perish here with hunger! I will arise and go to my father, and I will say to him, “Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Treat me as one of your hired servants.” Luke 15:17b-19

C. Commence **immediately**.

And he arose and came to his father . . . Luke 15:20a

1. Make a **covenant with God**.
2. Don’t take on **more debt**.
3. Put God **first in your giving**.
4. Develop a **written plan**.
5. Set an **attainable goal**.
6. Adjust your **lifestyle**.
7. Begin to **systematically pay debt**.
